GROUP PRAYER FOR THE FEAST OF ST.CHAVARA

Father son and Holy spirit, coming before your majestic and divine presence we adore you, praise you and worship you. Along with the angelic choirs and heavenly court let us sing to the Lord, the creator of us all. Retiring from the cares and worries of our daily toil let us be here in this holy ground at the eve of the feast of our dear saint and bless the name of the Almighty through a bhajan.

Bhajan...

St.Kuriakose Elias Chavara, a luminous star of the church, a man of God and prayer. As we celebrate the feast of St.Chavara let us have a glimpse of his life. Kuriakose Elias Chavara was born in 1805 of God fearing parents in the parish of Kainakary. When he was a little boy everybody admired him on account of his unusual piety and good character. He had a great devotion to Mother Mary which acquired from his mother, who always inspired him to lead a faithful life. Fr.Thomas Palackal, happened to meet our little Kuriakose, when he was eleven years old. He was impressed by the character and piety of the boy. He was taken to Pallipuram seminary in 1818. His Abba experience, Devotion to Blessed sacrament, docility to the will of God made him a great spiritual man. In 29th Nov 1829, his Excellency Bishop Maurelius stabilini, the vicar apostolic ordained him as priest. His first solemn Mass was celebrated in his own parish, Arthumkal. His extraordinary faith vision and divine inspirations as a young Priest forced him to start the first religious congregation for men on 11th may 1831 in Mannam. His farsighted vision and dedication made him start a Sanskrit school in Mannam in 1846. And first catholic Printing press was started by him in Mannam. In 1859 Leopoed Beccaro- an Ittalian missionary arrived in kerala and joined with him. They realised the need for spiritual realisation of women and both collaborated together and founded a congregation for women on 12th February 1866 known as CMC. In the loving providence of God, with 18Rs, they began their work. The pathetic situation of women in Kerala who were deprived of education and who were forced to do the household works, opened his eyes and he had taken special step for the upliftment of women & children, establishing many schools and giving training in handicrafts. He reformed liturgy and liturgical books. Moreover he was a great revolutionary who acted with farsighted vision, made a great impact in the church as he had started many renewal programs and devotional practices. On January 3,1871 at Koonamavu he died, accepting the pangs of his last illness patiently. Thus the great man of God kept his Baptismal sanctity till his death. He is remembered by all as his great contributions still stand in his memory. Let us sing the praises of the the Almighty for this man of God.

His exemplary life and unfailing faith made him a man of God and a man of prayer. O dear Saint your ceaseless efforts and hard toil gave colour and shape to CMC, though it had a simple beginning. "Great things happen when God mixes with us". It is truly reflected in your entire life. As you were lost in rapt attention before the Eucharistic Lord, You could act far ahead of your time with apostolic zeal within the 65 years of your earthly life. God's intervention in your life made you a man of multifaceted personality, a man of vision and mission and a great educationist and reformer. Your life was characterized by holiness, Simplicity, Spirit of prayer, detachment unquestionable obedience, God fearing habits and charitable disposition that raised you to the maximum height of sanctity. O dear Saint intercede for your loving daughters, so that we may imbibe your values and spirit in our lives. Let us strive hard to discern god's will and surrender our life at the feet of the Lord, Imparting God's love and light to the people around us through our witnessing life. May your undying sense of mission and unquenchable determination urge us to become firm in our conviction.Lord grant us the grace to face the challenges, withstanding power to

accept the hardships and move forward to you in contemplation and consecrated

to you in action like the saint. O Lord as your Persevered your Son's Baptismal

sanctity till death keep us pure and holy till our death. O dear saint, intercede for

each member of our congregation so that we may be able to prove that we are

your true daughters, render our service to God and his people specially for the
